- xi) U9 Voted in SNBMHL to allow player movement up to U11 (exceptional status). If the player is not rated in the top 1/3, then the player will have the option to play "A". U9 payers can affiliate up to U11 with a maximum of 45 games, including exhibition.
- xii) Dec 3-9 World Sledge Hockey Tournament in Quispamsis.
- xiii) KVMHA is planning to host Neuro-Diverse hockey clinics of 10 bi-weekly sessions.
- xiv) HNB is allowing video surveillance to be used in certain instances of coach/player/parent altercations.

- xv) Safe Sport Education Sessions are being offered by 3rd Party TBD.
- xvi) Rule change U18 automatic 4 min penalty for head contact and a 10-minute misconduct.
- xvii) If a single team has 7 suspensions, there will be a hearing.
- xviii) Bench Staff A certified bench staff volunteer can go on the ice to help an inured player without a mandatory removal form the game for 12 minutes.
- xix) Community Hockey this will be run by both local Central Midget Teams with Lynn Fletcher as the Coordinator.
- regarding payment for injured players. The competitive committee reviewed the current process and determined that it was fair and in line with the refund policy, to have the injured player pay the fee to tryout. The injured player process states that when a player is injured and physically unable to tryout, their level and evaluation from the previous year would be taken into account. If the player is injured and doesn't make the tryouts and is not placed on a team (based on above), they will not be required to pay. This was relayed to the board and all in attendance agreed with one objection noted.

Inclusivity and Right to Privacy | Presenter - Michael Wilson - Director of Administration

- i) Unfortunately, there were no applicants for the new Inclusivity Coordinator Position with KVMHA. Hopefully, some applicants will come forward in the near future.
- The Board recognizes the importance of abiding by Right to Privacy and the laws around protection of player and parent information. Therefore, Mike Wilson has created a RTIPPA Form that allows parents to opt-in to sharing of personal information with their authorized permission. These forms will be given to players soon. Next year, there will be an opt-in form on the registration site that will allow player's information to be listed on Team Snap.
